


## **Our Community**

At Peterborough Family Health Team, the communities we serve drive our planning and priorities. Peterborough and the surrounding community is undergoing significant change which we are planning for.

### Peterborough County is Growing and Aging

Peterborough County is currently home to 138,000 residents. Between 2006 and 2016, Peterborough County grew 4%, and all of that growth was accounted for in increases in those over the age of 65, with slight declines in population of those aged 0-14 and 15-64. This trend is expected to intensify over the coming years, with an increasing proportion of our population over the age of 65. Currently those 65 and older represent 23% of our overall population. By 2041, it is estimated that nearly  $1/3^{rd}$  of residents will be 65 and older as those from other parts of the province continue to view Peterborough County as an ideal place to retire.



### Your Priorities for Us

As part of this strategic planning process, we heard from hundreds of patients and residents on how we can improve and serve our community better. Your top priorities for us were:

- Improved wait-times and access to care
- Access to your health care information
- Assistance in identifying community services and programs
- Information toolkits and/or education sessions to help patients and residents better selfmanage their care
- Additional programs and services (thank you for your suggestions!)

This new Strategic Plan reflects our changing community, and what we have heard from you. While we will continue to depend on external partners for support in advancing some of these priorities, we will always be continually working to improve the care we provide and how we serve you!
